Amy Lowell Poetry Travelling Scholarship:


I am pleased to announce that Rebecca Lindenberg, of Logan, Utah, and CJ Evans, of San Francisco, California, have been chosen from among 363 applicants as the 2013-2014 Amy Lowell Poetry Travelling Scholars. In naming two Scholars the Judges have exercised their authority under the Will of Amy Lowell, as reformed in 2008, to do so if they determine that two applications "are of such exceptionally equal merit that to award the Scholarship to only one applicant would distinguish arbitrarily between the two."

Ms. Lindenberg is the author of "Love, An Index". Her poetry has been reviewed in Journals such as *City Weekly*, *Publisher's Weekly*, *Vanity Fair*, and *School Library Journal*. She is the recipient of various honors, including the Dorothy Sargent Rosenberg Poetry Prize, a MacDowell Arts Colony Residency, and a National Endowment for the Arts Literature Fellowship. Ms. Lindenberg currently teaches at Utah State University.

Mr. Evans is the author of two published books of poetry: "A Penance" and "The Category of Outcast". His work has appeared in Journals such as *Boston Review*, *Colorado Review*, *Indiana Review*, *Pleiades*, and *Virginia Quarterly Review*. He is the editor of Two Lines Press, and a contributing editor for *Tin House*.
